Years EYFS, 1 and 2

Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

As a fun Easter challenge, we are running a 'Design an Egg Character' competition in KS2.

The children are invited to create their own egg character. This can be a picture, model or even a real (hard-boiled please!) egg. Label the creation with the character name and some details about who or what they are.

Entries must be brought into school by Wednesday 25th March. This will allow them to be displayed for a couple of days and prizes to be awarded.



Easter egg raffle


The Easter egg raffle has become something of a Peel Common tradition and this year will be no different. Traditionally the raffle takes place on the last day of term and all children are able to buy raffle tickets which are drawn and an Easter egg is awarded to the lucky winners. In previous years, the raffle has taken place with the KS2 children in the Hall – but this year we are opening it up to all children across the school. The draw will happen on Thursday 26th March and eggs will be delivered on Friday 27th March to all of the lucky winners.

For this to happen, we do ask for donations of eggs to be sent in to school – these can be any eggs, from boxes of cream eggs to large eggs, whatever you are able to donate, we will add to the raffle. Children will have the opportunity to buy strips of raffle tickets – 5 tickets for £1 from Monday 20th March. These will be on sale from the school office, before school, after school and at breaktime only.

Please send your donated eggs in from Monday 20th March, they will be stored safely until the draw.

We look forward to seeing all of the fantastic entries into both competitions bonnets and eggs.
