Dear Parent/Carer

This half term, the children in Year 1 & 2 will be learning about the Titanic and exploring what life was like for a child on board the ship. They will also be investigating the main reasons why the Titanic sank and the important changes that were introduced as a result of the disaster.

To bring this unit of learning to a meaningful and engaging close, we are pleased to inform you that we have arranged an educational visit to the Sea City Museum in Southampton. During the visit, the children will have the opportunity to explore real stories from the Titanic, take part in a guided tour of the exhibition, and participate in a hands-on workshop linked directly to their learning in school.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 3rd June 2026 and is open to all children in Year 1 & 2. The cost of the visit is £30.00 per student, and the children will travel by coach. Due to the recent fuel increases, the charge for hiring coaches has been impacted quite drastically hence the cost of the trip this year. We will be leaving school at 9:00am and expect to return by 3:15pm.

Children should come to school wearing their full school uniform, along with comfortable footwear such as trainers, as the day will involve a considerable amount of walking.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them and a drink. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and you would like a lunch provided for them on the trip, please indicate on the Google Form (see link below) so a packed lunch can be prepared by the kitchen.
